

IMPORTANT VOTING INFORMATION

Date of Election: Tuesday, November 5, 2019

This is an All-Mail Ballot Election. No polling places will be open to vote in person. You must return your voted ballot by mail.

All active voters registered in Bullhead City will receive a ballot in the mail.

The last day to register to vote in the November 5, 2019 election is October 7, 2019.

Ballots will be mailed on October 9, 2019.

To replace a spoiled or missing ballot, or to inquire about the status of your voter registration, please contact the Mohave County Recorder's Office at 928-753-0767.

The Ballot Replacement Center will be open on Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2019, from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. located at the Mohave County Library, 1170 East Hancock Road, Bullhead City, to accept ballots not previously mailed or replace a lost or damaged ballot.

Ballots may also be dropped off at the Mohave County Recorder's Office in Kingman at 700 West Beale Street through Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2019, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Your mail-in ballot must be received by the Mohave County Recorder's Office before 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 5, 2019, in order to be valid and counted. The Mohave County Recorder's Office recommends mailing your ballot no later than six days prior to Election Day.
